

**ARMDALE YACHT CLUB  
RULES RESPECTING HOUSE**

1. Members must be prepared to show their membership cards on request. If they do not have their cards with them they may be asked to leave the premises. This rule pertains to all membership classifications.
2. A member in good standing must sign in a non-member as per the by-laws.
3. A member not in good standing shall not be admitted to the Club premises.
4. Members are responsible for the guest (non-members) they sign in. Members are required to remain in the clubhouse during the period their guest is present.
5. Members will show due respect at all time for other members, guests, employees, catering and bar staff.
6. The Armdale Yacht Club's liquor license is subject to the regulations and interpretations of the Nova Scotia Alcohol and Gaming Authority. AYC's Bar Policy will provide the Club's policy for the service, sales and distribution of alcoholic beverages for Armdale Yacht Club
7. Junior Members and all children under 19 years of age are not permitted in the Club premises where alcohol is being served and consumed after 21:00. This rule does not apply to wedding receptions and similar family events. If the Lower Bar is closed they may remain in that area after 21:00.
8. It is the responsibility of the Armdale Yacht Club catering and bar staff to enforce AYC's Bar Policy as directed by the Committee of Management.
